

## Clinical Leadership Programme Application

Welcome! We're delighted you're interested in joining the award winning Clinical Leadership programme, running from late autumn 2016 to September 2017. This programme will support you through leading yourself and your colleagues through the huge changes in the way the NHS works. Changes which have already started to have an impact on us, and will continue to do so.

This is a development programme which has the potential to bring about powerful shifts in how you work and how you live your life. Shifts which can have a very positive impact not only for you, but also for those you lead. But it is just potential, and one of the most significant factors in realising this potential is your desire to learn and develop as a leader. As a result there's a brief application process aimed at selecting the most appropriate participants. The programme isn't for everyone, rather for those who have a thirst to take in and apply as much as they can for the benefit of those around them. Oh, and you'll get a huge amount from it for yourself too!

The programme is recognised by Keele University, where Jo Leahy and Alastair Olby are honorary lecturers. If you wish to take a more academic approach in addition to the regular programme, you can choose to write up your project to gain a Post-graduate Award in Leadership and Management from Keele University, worth 30 credits. This would be at your own expense, costing £500.

## What do you need to know before applying?

For most participants time is the primary consideration. Here's what is required from you. The programme takes 8 days over 10 months in the Telford area. Please **only apply if you can commit to all the following dates and to holding the programme as a top priority in your life** over the coming year:

- 15th-16th November 2016
- 19th January 2017
- 8th-9th March 2017
- 13th-14th June 2017
- 19th September 2017



The programme also requires groups of participants to get together between modules for coaching and action learning sets. Exactly how often you do this is up to you, **but at a minimum, one action learning set (typically 90 – 120 minutes) and 4 coaching sessions (typically 30 – 60 mins) between modules.**

The second consideration is one of support: you will need the agreement of your organisation to support and pay for your participation. CCGs cannot cover locum costs for participants on the programme, but will support applications to apply for funding from other bodies if appropriate.
